

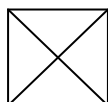
March Windmills

Cutting Requirements: make 6

Block size: 6 1/2"

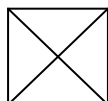
Light Fabric:

6 squares 4 1/4" x 4 1/4" cut diagonally twice A



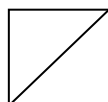
Dark Fabric:

6 squares 4 1/4" x 4 1/4" cut diagonally twice B



Medium Fabric:

12 squares 3 7/8" x 3 7/8" cut diagonally once C



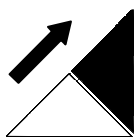
Contrasting Fabric: fabric to go between windmill blocks

2 rectangles 3" x 6 1/2"

1 rectangle 2" x 6 1/2"

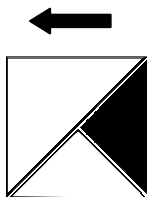
Assembly Requirements: the arrow shows the direction to press

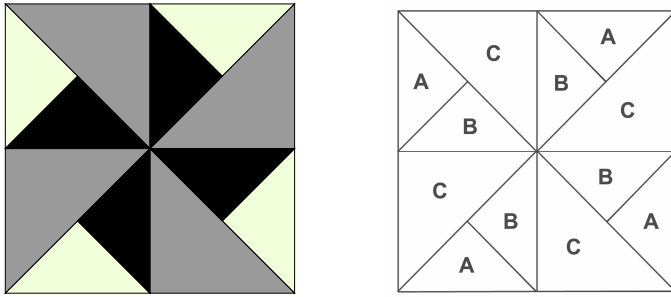
Sew one A triangle to one B triangle. Make 24 AB units.

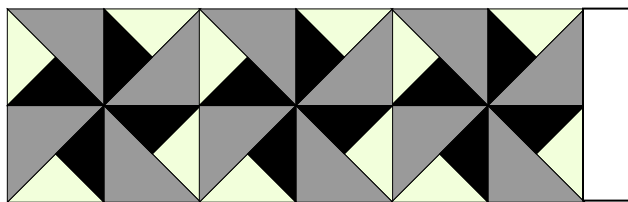
Sew one C triangle to one AB unit. Make 24 ABC units.

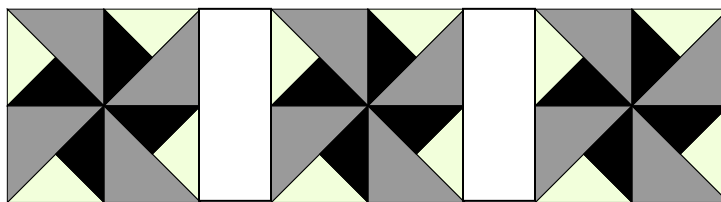


Sew ABC units together to finish the block

4. Sew 3 windmills together. Add the 2" x 6 1/2" rectangle to the end of these 3 blocks. Sew this section to the bottom of the snowflake block.



5. Sew one windmill to one 3" x 6 1/2" rectangle. Make 2 of these. Sew these two units together and add a windmill block to the end. You should have a row with a windmill, rectangle, windmill, rectangle, and windmill. Sew this section to the right side of the snowflake block.



This completes your March blocks.
