

November Leaves

Cutting Requirements:

Leaf Fabric: Make 3

Cut 3 squares 5 ½" x 5 ½"

Cut 9 squares 3" x 3"

Cut 9 squares 3 3/8" x 3 3/8"

Background Fabric:

Cut 9 squares 3" x 3"

Cut 9 squares 3 3/8" x 3 3/8"

Cut 6 squares 2 ¼" x 2 ¼"

Border Strips:

Cut 2 strips 3 ¼" x 72" for the sides of the quilt (I pieced this border with 9 strips of 8 ½" in length to measure the 72")


Cut 3 strips 1 ½" x 12" for in between the pumpkins

Cut 1 strip 2" x 30 ½" for the top of the leaves border


Cut 1 strip 3 ½" x 63 ½" for in between the center of the quilt and the pumpkin, leaves strip

Leaf Block Assembly Requirements:


1. Leaves: press one background fabric $3\frac{3}{8}$ " square in half or draw a pencil line from corner to corner on wrong side. Sew one background fabric to one leaf fabric $3\frac{3}{8}$ " square. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams on either side of the line. Cut in half on line to create 2 half square triangles. Make 6 for each leaf.



2. Stem: press a $2\frac{1}{4}$ " square in half. Sew a $2\frac{1}{4}$ " background square, on the pressed line, to each corner of the 3" leaf fabric. Trim excess. Make 1 for each leaf.



3. Piece leaf together by referring to the diagram below.



Border Assembly Requirements:

1. Sew a 3 ¼" x 72" strip to each side of the quilt center.
2. Sew the 3 ½" x 63 ½" border to the top of the quilt center.
3. Sew a 1 ½" x 12" strip in between each pumpkin. Set aside pumpkin strip.
4. Sew the 3 leaf blocks together. Sew the 2" x 30 ½" border to the top of the 3 leaves.
5. Join the pumpkin strip and leaves strip together.
6. Sew strip to the top of the quilt.
7. This completes the blocks through November. We will finish the rest of the quilt next month.
